

## School-based apprenticeship and traineeship (SBAT) information

SBATs are more than just part-time jobs - they're a great way to set yourself up for the career you want whilst you are completing your HSC.

SBATs allow students to commence an apprenticeship, or complete a traineeship while at school.

School based apprenticeships and traineeships (SBATs) provide students with the opportunity to:

- Attain a nationally recognised Vocational Education and Training (VET) qualification
- Complete the Higher School Certificate, some courses can contribute towards your Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR).
- Gain valuable work skills and experience through paid employment

An example of a School-Based Apprentice at work:
